**PURPOSE**

- The Land and Resource Strategic Plan attempts to build capacity through the support and development of Douglas First Nation visions, traditional use studies, inventorying lands and resources within traditional territories, joint ventures and partnerships, and work experience programs with both the private and public sectors.
- The Land and Resource Strategic Plan will work together with the management of lands and resources (implementing GIS)
- Issues related to land and resources are of concern to Douglas First Nation, regardless of their relationship (if any) to the treaty process.
- Need to identify potential of traditional lands including reserve lands.

**GOALS**

- The strategic plan is developed as an early building block to guide capacity building in Douglas First Nation.
- To provide the ability and opportunity for Douglas and their members to pursue economic development initiatives effectively, efficiently, and sustainably.
- Resources made available to Douglas for the development of a comprehensive, community based strategic plan.
- Providing the trainee with the ability to gather information, obtain research skills, and have the ability to research archives at the Department of Indian Affairs in Vancouver. This will allow Douglas First Nation to expand the information contained within their system.
