



Utility System Restoration Calgary Airport Authority

Over 2,000 metres of water, gravity sewer and sewage forcemain were replaced at the Calgary International Airport.

The project was phased to ensure that there were no service disruptions to adjacent users. Users in the area included the Canadian Airlines hangar and office facility, the airport fire station, Cara kitchens, and several airline service companies. Some of these users had sophisticated fire suppression equipment and their requirements for available fire flow were very specific. These concerns were managed throughout the design and construction processes.

The project was completed on schedule and under budget to the satisfaction of the Airport Authority.
